

## **Clearwire's WiMAX network expands in the States – but is it too late?**

Clearwire has launched its WiMAX service in Las Vegas, which makes it the fourth city covered by Clearwire. The other cities are Baltimore, Atlanta and Portland. The equipment for the network is provided by Motorola. The cost of the service starts at USD 20 per month for home service and USD 30 per month for mobile service. One-day passes cost USD 10.

The pace of WiMAX network launches has been quite slow so far and even though this is expected to speed up this autumn, one may wonder if mobile WiMAX has any chance against HSPA and LTE networks which will have much wider coverage and much better device availability.
